If you are unsure as to whether your application will make it in time for the deadline by mail, please send them by email. Only applications received by noon (Pacific Time) on Wednesday January 17th, 2024 will be accepted even if they were originally mailed by this date.

Who Is Eligible to Apply:

Any new or current students and their families may apply for scholarships.

Please note that, to apply for a scholarship, a student must either be enrolled or officially offered **Full-Time or Half-Day** enrollment at Eaton Arrowsmith Redmond or Eaton Arrowsmith Vancouver (including adult programs) for the 2024-2025 school year. Prospective students must have already started the admissions process.

Scholarships cannot be applied to tuition at Eaton Arrowsmith School Online.

Application and Notification Process:

All applications must be submitted by 12:00pm (noon) Pacific Time on Wednesday January 17th 2024, and successful applicants will be notified by January 19th 2024. Students will have until January 24th, 2024 to accept their scholarship by confirming registration for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Please Note:

- Families can apply for multiple scholarships but each student can receive only one.
- Scholarships can be combined with discounts received through the [EA Champion Program](#).
- If awarded, scholarship would be awarded before other discounts are applied if applicable.
- **Please submit only ONE (1) essay or presentation per student.**
- Please submit all scholarship application documents as one package by mail, in person or by email.
- Scholarships are awarded annually and cannot be deferred or applied to another year and cannot be transferred to a different program.
- Scholarships are limited and subject to availability year to year.
- This application will not be considered complete unless all required documents have been submitted.
- *We encourage you to submit your application early so that you have time to change it if necessary (i.e. if it does not meet requirements) - if you submit your application before January 15th, we can let you know whether it meets the application requirements.*

Required Documents:

Application for Scholarship Cover Page (page 3 of this document). Please ensure all sections of the form are completed.

Persuasive Presentation on "**Resiliency**":

- Either:
 - ONE (1) **video/audio** (maximum time 3 minutes) *or*
 - ONE (1) **PowerPoint presentation** (maximum 10 slides including maximum totals of: 200 words, 5 photos /drawings, 1 minute video, included in Power Point) *or*
 - ONE (1) **written essay** (maximum 500 words), which can be accompanied by ONE (1) photo or drawing
- ***To be fair to other applicants, do not exceed the limitations outlined above. If submitted early enough for our Scholarship & Bursary team to review, applications that do not meet these criteria may be shortened by the applicant and resubmitted.***
- This can be written/created by the student and/or by the student's family
- This should address the topic of "Resiliency"
- Please note that only ONE essay or presentation should be submitted per student.
- Video files may be mailed or dropped off at the school on a USB drive which will be returned to you. Do NOT send via Google drive. Drop Box is preferred if file size is too large for email.
- Persuasive Presentation must contain the student's first and last name.
